Truancy is against the law. Michigan's Compulsory School Attendance Law requires that every child (from the age of 6 to 18) attend school- on time, every day.

WHY IT MATTERS:



- TRUANCY (especially among elementary school students) have several negative, long term effects, such as:
 - Students who miss school at an early age <u>WILL</u> fall behind their classmates.
 - More likely to drop out of school.



- They are more likely to become disengaged from their studies.
- Struggle academically
- Develop behavior problems
- Struggle socially and emotionally

CHRONIC ABSENCE - <u>18</u> or more days
WARNING SIGNS - <u>10</u> to 17 days

SATISFACTORY - <u>9</u> or fewer absences


