Dear Parents/Guardians,

Starting on Tuesday, March 2, 2021, all high school students who have been attending school face-to-face will transition to remote learning from home through Friday, March 5. High School students currently in face-to-face instruction will return to their classrooms on Monday, March 8, 2021.

The district is making this transition to remote learning due to the district’s inability to meet the capacity needs of staffing every classroom. All After School activities may continue as scheduled. All CTE, and Dual Enrollment classes will continue as scheduled. The high school virtual schedule will be as follows:

Additional detailed information will be communicated to high school parents, students, and staff by the building principal.

The school district continues to be a safe learning environment for our staff and students. Less than 1% of all positive COVID cases in Berrien County have been associated with a school setting. Our school district will continue to be vigilant about the mitigation protocols and practices that are currently implemented. I ask that our Shamrock families continue to emphasize safe and healthy practices outside of the school environment. These practices will help to reduce the risk of transmission in our communities.
